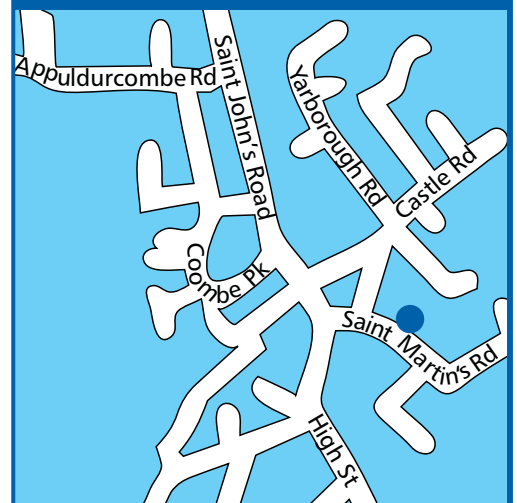
Worsley Court is a sheltered scheme for older people who want to retain their independence but access support from our staff. The scheme is situated a short distance from the shops, community centre and local churches.

The scheme has a manager and is linked to the Wightcare out-of-hours emergency service. Social activities such as whist drives and bingo are held in the communal lounge. Coffee mornings and afternoon tea are available.

The scheme also has a kitchen, guest room, laundry room, attractive gardens and car parking.

We welcome residents from all sections of the community.

# Sheltered housing schemes

South Wight Housing Association provides self-contained flats in 10 sheltered housing schemes on the Isle of Wight for more than 300 people aged 60 or over.

To apply for a place, older people will need to put their names down on the Isle of Wight Council housing register.

At sheltered housing schemes, residents sign up to an assured tenancy agreement and work with our staff to draw up a plan of the support they will receive. The cost of this support may be met by funding from the Council's Supporting People budget for residents who are eligible.

Each scheme has a manager who provides

support while on duty. Out of hours, residents have access to a community alarm call system.

Scheme managers will:

- support residents to manage their tenancies
- make daily calls to all residents
- promote continued independence
- encourage residents to get involved in scheme activities
- involve other organisations that have resources to offer our residents.

Alongside the flats, schemes usually provide some shared facilities. For details see the front of this leaflet.
