Argyll Street is our registered care home for eight people with learning disabilities.

The house is situated near Ryde Town Centre and within easy reach of local facilities. Argyll Street aims to enable people with learning disabilities to live as independently as possible. Staff support and care is designed to meet each person's individual needs and is provided 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

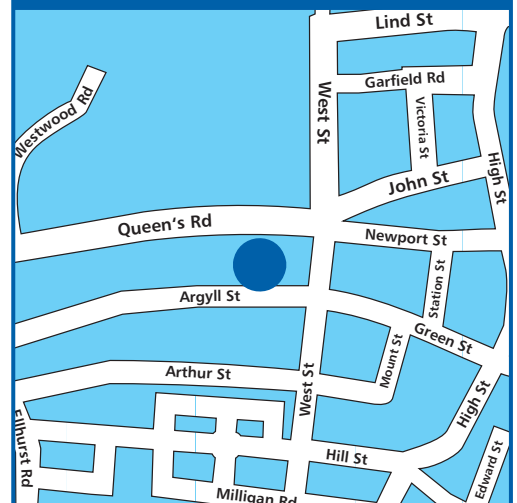
The house has a communal lounge and kitchen, laundry room, computer facilities and a garden at the rear.

Regular residents' meetings are held to exchange ideas and views and residents are encouraged to make use of facilities and activities within the community.

# Registered care for adults with learning disabilities

22 Argyll Street is registered with the Commission for Social Care Inspection.

To be offered a place, a person with a learning disability must be referred by social services before being assessed. We also work in partnership with Fair Haven Housing Trust and with the prior agreement of social services, they may nominate prospective residents. Fair Haven contribute generously to this scheme and have recently funded the building of a conservatory.

Each resident has a plan which sets out the support and care they will receive, the cost of which is either funded by social services or, in some cases, by independent means.

We provide staff at the house whose job is to:

- provide support and personal care
- promote greater independence
- encourage personal safety
- encourage resident involvement, both within the house and the wider community
- work in partnership with other organisations and residents' families for the benefit of residents
- assist residents to manage their finances
- help to develop residents' domestic, social and life skills.
