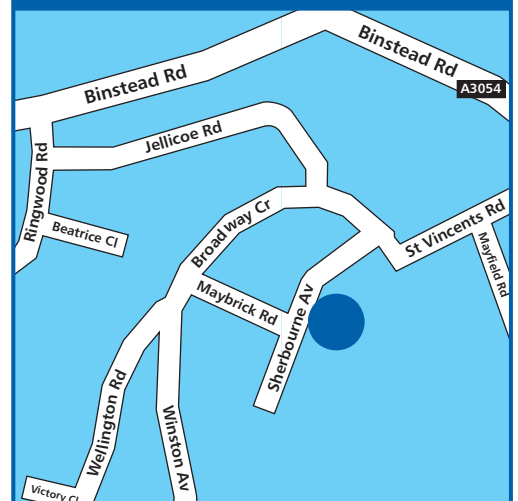
Sherbourne Avenue provides eight unfurnished bedsits, each with cooking facilities, shower and toilet. There is a communal kitchen and lounge, with access to the garden.

Our staff team provide support, care and housing management services as required. The scheme is linked to an out-of-hours emergency service that will contact our on-call officer if necessary.

We welcome residents from all sections of the community.

Schemes for adults with learning disabilities

Southern Housing Group provides accommodation with shared facilities for people with learning disabilities, at various locations on the Isle of Wight.

To be offered a place, applicants must be referred by one of our partner agencies, such as social services, before being assessed. Alternatively, applicants may be considered under the Island Homefinder scheme.

Residents sign up to an occupancy agreement and a support and care plan as required.

We provide staff whose job is to:

- support residents to maintain their occupancy agreements
- provide personal care where required
- promote independence
- encourage personal safety
- help residents manage their finances, including claiming benefits and paying their rent
- improve residents' domestic and social skills
- encourage residents to get involved in scheme and community activities
- where appropriate, help to find alternative homes for residents to move on to
- involve other organisations that have resources to offer our residents.
