This scheme, which is situated a short walk from Sandown town centre and the beach, provides a temporary home with support for homeless people.

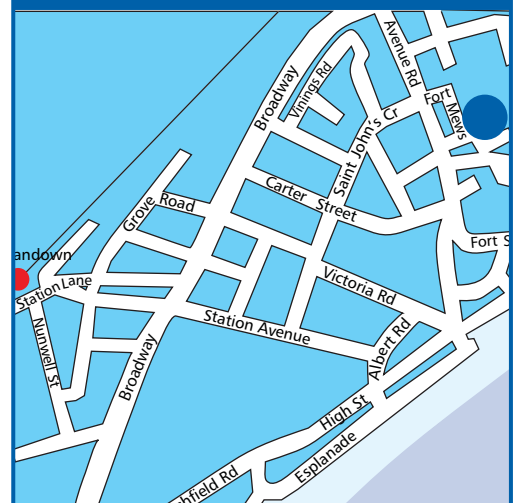
Yarborough House comprises 21 rooms, each one with its own kitchen area, cooker and refrigerator. Residents share a bathroom, laundry facilities and a residents' day room. The scheme also has one self-contained, three bedroom flat.

Rooms are unfurnished, but our support staff work with local organisations to provide items such as beds and sofas. The scheme is linked to an out-of-hours emergency service, who will contact our on-call officer if necessary. There is CCTV in communal areas.

We welcome residents from all sections of the community.

Hostel for homeless people

Southern Housing Group provides temporary accommodation with shared facilities at this hostel for homeless people.

Residents sign an occupancy agreement and work with staff to draw up a plan of the support they will receive while living at the scheme.

At the hostel, staff provide on-site support while on duty and a housing management service.

They:

- support residents to manage their occupancy agreements
- promote independence
- encourage personal safety
- help residents to manage their finances – including claiming benefits and paying their rent

- work to improve residents' domestic and social skills
- help to find permanent homes for residents to move on to and continue to provide support when they have moved
- encourage residents to get involved in scheme activities
- involve other agencies that have resources to offer our residents.
